## FUSED GLASS SNOWFLAKES

**Sunday, Sept. 29, 2024, 1 – 4 pm**

Students will explore the wonderful world of kiln-formed glass. Kiln formed glass is an art form where separate pieces of glass are subjected to high heat (1200 F to 1600 F) to “fuse” the pieces together. Students will create fused glass snowflakes. The snowflakes will measure 6 inches across, suitable for wall decorations.

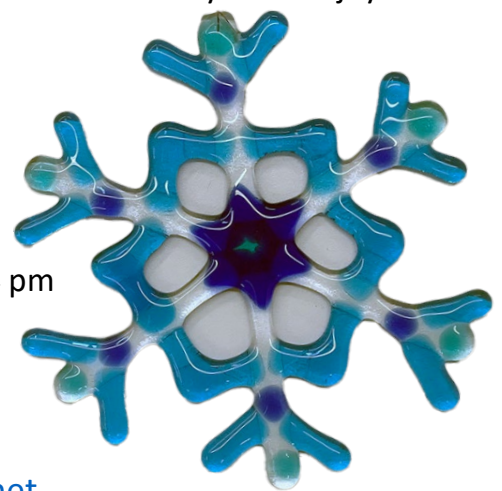
- learn about cutting glass, the physics of glass and the art of glass

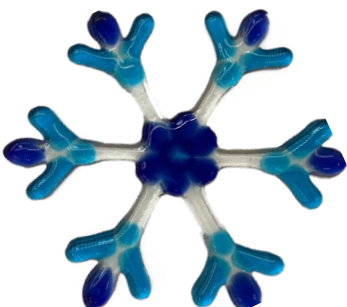
